Program Note

Rebates are available on a first come first serve basis and are subject to availability of funds. These rebates may be discontinued at any time. Beginning **January 1, 2012** Central Lincoln PUD (CLPUD) incentives will be limited to **70%** of the total project cost. Please call 1.888.883.9879 if you have any questions.

Program Eligibility

Manufactured home residences must have a permanently installed electric heat system capable of heating the entire dwelling in order to qualify for rebates.

Central Lincoln PUD (CLPUD) reserves the right to inspect completed work. Rebates will be paid only on work that meets CLPUD specifications. If not familiar with specifications please contact us at 1.888.883.9879.

Qualifying Energy Efficiency Improvements

Weatherization rebates apply only to upgrades on existing homes; not new construction. The following energy efficiency improvements qualify for a rebate:

- Attic Insulation
- Under Floor Insulation

Rebate requests must be submitted within 6 months of purchase. Please allow 8 – 10 weeks for processing.

Manufactured Home Insulation:

- ◆ Attic Insulation - Existing is less than R-11 increased to Minimum R-19 - \$0.18 per sq/ft
- ◆ Floor Insulation - Existing is less than R-11 increased to Minimum R-19 - \$0.20 per sq/ft

Inspection – When CLPUD receives your rebate application, you will be contacted to schedule an inspection of the completed work. **IMPORTANT: All measures must be installed according to CLPUD’s specifications. If you or your contractor is not familiar with the program specifications, please contact us prior to beginning work at 1.888.883.9879.**

Project Completion

Rebates will be paid when CLPUD has received a complete Weatherization Rebate Application, complete contractor’s final invoice, and the work has been inspected and approved by a CLPUD representative. Contractor’s final invoice or proposal **must include** R-value of existing insulation, R-value of final insulation, and square footage of added insulation.
